May Term 1833 The last will and testament of
John Allen Woodruff deceased was proven in open
Court by the oath of Phiby Woodruff a subscribing
Witness thereto (in words as follows to wit—)

December the Twenty-second eighteen & and Thirtynine
This day the party in body but sound reason having to
mind the mortality of my body and the short time of life
I do make this my last will and testament as follows that
is to say after my body decently buried I give and
bequeath to my beloved wife Jane Woodruff a certain
tract of land containing one hundred acres whereon
I now live with my mansion house and all that appertains
thereto with one negro woman Maria and one good
bed and furniture and all my house hold furnished with
the exception of a bed a peare for three children and
two good Cows and three goes and a filly mare two years
old and my chit which she may feasibly enjoy during
life at my wifes death I give to my four Children
William Woodruff and Henry Woodruff and young A
Woodruff and Andrew J Woodruff the above mentioned property
To be equally divided among the above mentioned four
children I also give to my son John M Woodruff
that tract of land consisting six hundred acres including
the tract whereon he now lives and other property to
the amount of five hundred dollars to him and his
heirs for ever I also give to my son Aaron Woodruff
all the property that I have given him as his part
of my estate to him and his heirs for ever to the amount
of five hundred Dollars I give to my Daughter Mary
Hollaway one negro girl by the name Susanah and other
property to the amount of five hundred dollars to her and
her heirs for ever I also give my son Moses Woodruff
a portion of lands and other property which he shall possess
to the amount of five hundred dollars to him and his heirs
for ever I also give to my daughter Fannie one
negro girl by the name of Lizzie and other property to

the amount of five hundred dollars to her and her
heirs for ever I also give to my son Andrew Woodruff
one negro child name Price and one mare named to come to
him and his heirs for ever I also give to my son
Henry Woodruff one mare which he shall had to him and
his heirs for ever the balance of my property I give
to be divided amongst my four children William Woodruff
Henry Woodruff Allen Woodruff and Andrew Woodruff

I do appoint my son John Woodruff Executor
to this my last will and Testament whereunto I
