


The Last Will and Testament of Joshua Roark

 N.C. Being in sound mind doth make
 this my last will and Testament of
 my personal property only.

I Bequeath and
 give unto my wife Rhoda three Milk
 cows & calves one yoke of oxen one Bull
 and one heifer two head of horses, Eleven
 head of sheep ten head of Hogs and
 Eleven Bee stands and all my house-
 hold and kitchen furniture all for
 her Benefit-as long as she lives and
 at her death if any of the above property
 is left the same is to be given to my son
 J. W. Roark I further give & Bequeath unto
 my said wife Rhoda all of my Farming
 utensils and also two notes I hold against
 John & Robert Latham to the amount of
 fifty odd Dollars I further give and bequeath
 unto my Daughter Rebecca Elliott one Bee
 stand

I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter
 Marlicia Poteu one Bee stand I give
 and Bequeath unto my Daughter Cora
 & Poteu one Bee stand I Bequeath
 and give unto my Daughter Bethana
 five one Bee stand It is my will and
 Testament-that my wife Rhoda Roark
 pay to each of my Daughters to wit Rebecca
 Elliott Marlicia Poteu Cora & Poteu and
 Bethana four. The sum of five Dollars each
 the same to be paid out of my personal
 property. I here by appoint Joseph Dougherty
 my Executor of this my last will and
 Testament-given written my hand
 and seal this the 13th day of Oct-1832

 under any restraint to the knowledge
 information or belief of this deponent and

the said Floyd Welch and Elizabeth Welch
all my personal property at my death and
also all my house hold kitchen furniture
together with all other property that I may

own at my death - now if the said Floyd
Welch and Elizabeth Welch shall care and truly
support and take good care of the said Nancy
Miller her natural life, fine the above will to
to be in full force other wise to be void
