State of North Carolina Ashe County  
To all to whom this may be known that I am  
in my sound and rite mind and I do  
now make my last will and testament

First I will and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Minta Pugh all my house furniture with all  
my farming tools and smith tools and all  
my cattle which is ten head together with  
all my shap and hogs and all my bus and  
I also will and bequeath to my wife Minta  
Pugh one young sorrel mare two years old  
and all my grain and Bacon which I have  
now on hand this I Bequeath to my wife  
Minta Pugh also I will and bequeath to my  
wife Minta one cash note on Greenbury  
Shipp's the amount of Twenty dollars and  
Eighty five cents with interest to gether with  
all other notes dues or demands coming to  
me I will and bequeath to my wife Minta Pugh  
with the exception of Four dollars I bequeath  
to my son James Pugh out of the above men-  
tioned money and also four dollars to my  
son William Pugh and to my daughter Rege  
Evans I will and bequeath to her four dollars  
of the above mentioned money and my Daughter  
Nancy Redford I will and bequeath to her  
four dollars more of the above named money  
and my wife Minta to pay over this money  
to the heirs when collected I also will and  
bequeath to my grandson William Pugh son of <sup>James</sup> William  
Pugh one young gray mare three years old also my saddle  
I will I bequeath to my grand son William Pugh this be-  
ing my last will and testament and I do hereunto  
set my hand and affix my seal this the 18<sup>th</sup> day of  
April 1845
