Sandrine Eggers Will

In the name of God Amen, I Sandrine Eggers of the County of Ashe and North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory, blessed be God for his mercy This the 26th day of June A.D. 1834. do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in the words following to wit; First, I give and bequeath my soul to God who gave it hoping that at the great day of the dissolution of all things on earth that he will raise both soul and body to eternal life, secondly I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Johana all my house hold furniture except one clock & Bureau. I also bequeath to said Johana the debt coming from Valentine Reese for her support her lifetime, I also ordain that at her death she dispose of what property she leaves at her own discretion, Thirdly, I give and bequeath to Johana Reese Valentine Reese & wife, my clock & Bureau, at her death to belong to her daughter Joana, Fourthly, I give and bequeath to John Reese Valentines bar, one set of blacksmith tools, Fifthly I request and by this will ordain that all my just debts be paid, out of the debts that is owing to me and the overplus if any I want divided in the following manner first, ten Dollars in trade to each of Mary Fords Eleven children 2nd that each of Valentines nine children have each Ten Dollars in trade 3rd I will and bequeath that the residue if any be equally divided between my wives six children viz. Hannah, Sarah Mary, Hugh Joana, & Lydia, 4th I will and ordain that my worthy friend Valentine Reese & N. Bingham be my executors to execute the above will and make the distribution of my effects as I have prescribed in writing whereof I have subscribed my hand this day & date first above written.
