Fletcher first Survey of said Part tract of Land Adjoining
The Lands of Ed B Coe & others shall be Equally divided
Between my two daughters Sarah Ann and Amanda
and there assigned it is my will that my daughter
Caroline Parter have my tract of Land known
as the Parter land adjoining the Lands of John Grubbs
& others with absolute right to disposed of as she may
desire It is my will that my tract of Land adjoining
the lands of Thomas Keytralls and others and so
much of my Personal Property as is necessary to pay
my Just debts if any be paid by my Executors and
Payment made and that all of her said property if not
said or whatever is left at the death of my wife be
Equally divided between my daughters Polly Senter
Patsy Duvall Caroline Parter Sarah Ann and
Amanda and my son John and the children
of my eldest son Andrew Wise, Mary John
James and Andrew Kay and if my son John
Gentry of Calaparnay and Polly Senter of Massena
do not come to receive their share of my property
as a have divided and bequeathed to them with in
two years after the death of my wife then my
Executor shall pay over their shares of said
Property to my grand childrens the heirs of
Andrew Gentry above named and I hereby
appoint my wife Nancy Gentry and my sons
in Law J B Duvall & Clark Parter Executors
of this will in testimony whereof I have hereunto
