

Mary Phillips' Will

March 5th 1844.

In the name of God Amen. I Mary Phillips of the County of Ashe and State of North Carolina being weak of body but of a sound and disposing mind do make ordain constitute & publish this my last Will & Testament.

- First. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca Phillips my clothe.
- Second I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Mary Phillips daughter of John Phillips one Feather Bed Bedstead & Bed Cloathing
- Third I give and bequeath to my Grand daughter Matilda Baker daughter of James & Mary Baker all the balance of my property goods and effects of every kind whatsoever. To wit Consisting of one Yellow Mare seven head of cattle Ten head of sheep Ten head of hogs. with all the increase of said stock of every kind, all my household and kitchen furniture, ~~with~~ of every kind with all my farming utensils together with all the grain & Bacon I have on hand at my decease, lastly I appoint my friend Richard Gentry my Executor of this my last Will & Testament.
