

# Will of Nancy May

uncertainty of this frail and Mortal  
life do therefore make publish and declare  
this to be my last will and testament that is to say  
First after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged the  
residue of my Estate real and personal I give bequeath and  
dispose of as follows to wit.

To my beloved Brother and Sisters, one dollar each.

To John May, Jacob May's son Elizabeth Hawks May  
Margaret Stuart, Catherine May, and the balance of thy  
estate to John May, Catherine May's son, excepting my  
business. Will to the said John May, May's son, The property I will  
to John May Catherine May's son consisting of one grey horse  
one Cow two hogs and bedsteads and all three thereto one  
wreath two wheels one lamp one side saddle and all of my  
Household and Kitchen furniture & give by each what  
I will, all the residue and remainder of my real and  
personal estate. To John May Catherine May's son and his  
heirs likewise I make and constitute Resin Jones to be  
executor of this my last will and testament made by me  
as witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and  
affixed my seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1869
