Just Debts are paid. I Give & Bequeath to my
 Loving father & Mother all my Estate both Real
& Personal (I want my family of Negroes
except Ben & John his wife & George his son & also
all my other Estate for them to have & enjoy & injoy during
their Natural Lives & all the profits arising there
from except a Balance of Money that is owing to
me for little White paper is in my Name
& the money coming to me on that line of
business I leave to my Beloved Brother George
Phillips to Collect & keep for his own money
& at the Order of my Loving father & Mother
Jonathan & Mary Phillips
& if there is any of Estate left or what ever
I shall Remain I wish Equally Divided Between
all of my Brothers & Sisters & my Sister Dolly
Daughter Abigaila Baker Every one to have an Equal
Share & I leave my Brother George Phillips my
Sole Executor to Manage all my affairs after
my death and Want my family of Negroes
Kept to Gather & not parted
where unto I have set my hand & Seal
as my last will & Testament Signed & sealed
in presence of us
