

Home Stead of Natham Phillips.
State of North Carolina

Alta County March the 23. 1869

We the freeholders of said County having been summoned and duly sworn proceed to lay off and allot to Natham Phillips his home Stead in real estate bounded as follows. Beginning in the Gap between him and Johnson on a chestnut and a Spanish Oak, Rebecca Phillips old corner running South 84 one hundred and sixty four poles to a White Oak near Millseat said Rebecca's old corner, thence South 84, E, 50 poles to a Spanish Oak, thence South 40 E 52 poles to a maple near the creek, thence east 100 poles to a chestnut at a branch below the school house, then up the branch to a white oak John Hanthorns corner near said school house, then west with Hanthorns corner one hundred and ten poles to a Spanish Oak & chestnut said Hanthorns corner, then North twenty poles to a chestnut, then North 22 E 60 poles to a White Oak, then South 80 west eighty poles to the beginning, making one hundred acres. The 2 tract beginning on a Spanish Oak Lerion corner the head of Mill Creek running North 30 west one hundred poles to a chestnut, then west 30 South one hundred and sixty poles to a Spanish Oak near a branch, then South 31, E, one hundred poles to a white Oak near a Millseat then to first station containing one hundred acres, the above lands being all the same and all the lands the said Natham Phillips owns - valued at five hundred dollars given under our hands and seals.
