Do this 15th day of March in the Year of our Lord
one Thousand eight hundred & thirty eight
do Make ordain & Publish this my last

& one white cow & six two year old hegs
& the half of my household furniture

Franky Greer I Give & Bequeath one Red heifer
of three years old & one Black heifer of two
years old & one Red & white yearling & one
other Red & white yearling & one Red & white
cow & one Black cow & one Black yearling
with a white Back & one other Brown yearling
& Thirteen head of Sheep & my shirt &
half of my household furniture & my largest
Pot & all the Ballance of my hegs after Giving
the six above Mentioned to my Daughter
Nancy & one hundred & twenty five Pounds
of Bacon & one hundred Pounds of Lard
& one hundred & fifty Pounds of Potatoes

& all the Ballance of my Town after Gearing my
 Daughter Nancy the above mentioned Ten Bushels
 & all my Hay & oats & all my Ruff feed of all sorts
 & my Bed that my Son Hugh Lays on
