

Reuben Rob^r. Will

In the name of God Amens I Reuben Rob of
 the County of Ashe & State of North Carolina
 being in perfect mind & memory thanks
 given unto God calling unto mind
 the mortality of my body knowing
 that it is appointed for all men
 once to die, make & ordain this
 my last Will & Testament, That is to
 say, Properly & first, of all I give
 & recommend my soul to almighty
 God that gave it & my body I commit
 end to the earth to be buried in a
 decent Christian burial at the discretion
 of my Executors, nothing doubting
 but at the General Resurrection
 I shall receive the same again by
 the mighty power of God. And as
 touching such worldly estate whereunto
 it has pleased God to bless me in this
 world I give devise & dispose of the same
 in the following manner, & first I give
 and bequeath to my beloved wife
 Mary Robs. fifty four acres of land
 during her widowhood part of the tract
 I now live on Beginning at the north end
 on a Red oak running south eighty
 poles to a stake then west 100 poles to a
 stake then North 80 poles to two white
 oaks. then East 100 poles to the begin
 ing also one bed & furniture one cow &
 calf choice of my stock one bay
 mare called fly which property to be
 equally divided between my two young
 children at my wifes decease
 except the land given to my wife
 which is at her decease or end of her
 widow hood to be given to my son
 Washington Troy. also I give & bequeath

to my son John part of two tracts of
 land supposed to be sixty five acres
 more or less. on the south side of the
 North Fork of New River including said
 John's improvements, unto my son Thomas
 I give & bequeath a certain piece of
 land lying on the west side of the
 old tract part of a new survey
 Beginning on a sugar tree on the bank
 of the North Fork of New River in the
 old line running unto said line north
 passing the old corner until it inter
 sects the southernmost line of my Grassy
 Creek tract then west to a chestnut cor
 ner of the new survey near the fork of
 the mill path, then west 60 poles to a
 Spanish oak then south 80 poles to a
 black gum on the north bank of North
 fork of New river then down the
 several courses of said river one
 hundred & seventy poles to a sugar tree
 Rosas old line being the first station
 unto my son Andrew I give fifty four
 acres of land being part of the land
 I live on beginning at the lynn sprouts
 running north with the old line to a red
 oak corner then north 32 poles to a ches
 nut oak then east to a white oak then
 with the conditional line to a poplar
 on the north fork of New river then
 up the river to the beginning also one
 brown horse colt, unto my son
 Wilborn I give fifty four acres of
 land being part of the land I
 live on Beginning at the lynn sprouts
 running west up the north side of
 the North fork to a lynn tree, in the
 old line then north 80 poles to a Stake.

there one hundred poles to a state then souther
 Eighty poles to the first station the tyne of
 souls, Also I give to my beloved son Alfred
 One hundred acres of land situate on
 Grassy Creek waters of New river begining
 at Chestnut Henry Smiders corner running
 west to Stones corner then north so as to
 include 28 acres of my new 220 acre
 survey & it is to be understood that if the
 said Alfred dies before he arrives of age
 then the said land to belong to Mr Tracy
 my youngest son.

I also will & bequeath to my beloved
 daughter Anna one cow & calf, two
 ewes & lambs, also I will to my beloved
 daughter Providence one bed & furniture
 two ewes & lambs, unto my beloved
 daughter Rebecca I give one flat
 wheel one bed & furniture.

It is to be understood that I wish my
 young horse retained in my family
 at home for the use of my wife and
 little ones. Unto my beloved daughter
 Elizabeth I give four sheep one small
 heifer, As respects the balance of my
 property not named in this will
 & testament, I bequeath it to my
 wife & small children for their use
 until the children comes of age I
 also will to my first children to wit
 Sarah Edward, William James may
 say each twenty five cents.

Be it known that I consteate
 made & ordain the sole executor of
 this my last will & Testament, all
 & singular my last messages and
 by them truly to be possessed & enfo
 rced & do hereby utterly disallow

revoked & does annul all & every other
former. testament. will & legacy by
me & Executor by me in my will
by me before named will & Testament
in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 8th day
of September in the year of our Lord
1829.
