

Samuel Songs Will.

In the name of God amen I Samuel Song
of the County of Ashe and State of North
Carolina being in my proper mind & memory
and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following to wit,

I Give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Polly Song one third of the tract of
land on Rock Creek bought of William Phipps
in Ashe County during her natural life &
then to be disposed of as hereinafter directed
and one sow man and one cow and calf and
all the household furniture. I will to my
son Morgan Song one tract of land in the
State of Virginia and Grayson County containing
one thousand & fifty acres on Rock Creek,
I will to my daughter Rhoda Davises one
tract of land in Grayson County on the west
side of Pond lookout mountain containing
two hundred acres more or less. I will to my
daughter Sally Carico one note on Barnard
Carico for about twenty six dollars. I will to my
daughter Sally Sam with one note on Barnard
Carico for about nine or ten dollars accounts
I will to my daughter Charlotte Sam with
Twenty five dollars in money. I will to my
son Emanuel Song three dollars in money. I
will to my daughter Polly Song one hundred
dollars in money one cow & calf I will to
my daughter Anna Song one hundred and
ten dollars in money. I will to my daughter
Lucinda Song one hundred & ten dollars in
money. I will to my son Joseph and my son
Joseph Song the Phipps tract of land in Ashe
County to be equally divided between them
when they become of age also my two
rifles guns. The balance of my property
not herein enumerated I used to be
sold at publick sale and the proceeds

made equal one with the other according to the
valuation and when they are all made equal
and there is an oversplus I wish it equally
divided amongst my children, to my girls
children and their heirs and not to be de-
posited without the consent of my daughter
by her husband, and for it to belong to them
& their heirs, and should my wife Sarah
Conwell think fit to have a division of any
of the property sooner, she can call the heirs
together and dispose of it as she and her
sons agree w^t themselves, and should
this not be property enough to make the
girls equal to my sons according to this
valuation made in this instrument of
writing my intention is that the boys
are not to pay any thing back to the Estate
in writing whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this day and date before
written.
