head and sheep three head and hog one head
and all my bacon grain & luffups and one
wheel bar and farming implements. and further
that the said Nathan Barren have all my money
and notes and interest. one note on J.B. Sheets
the principal whereof is fifty three dollars at
per cent. also one on Battell Barre of fifteen
dollars at per cent. further I will that the said Nathan
Barren have all my bees at John Barres William Tyale
and W.D. Tyale. Also I will that the said Nathan
Barren have what he is due me free and peaceable
and my household and Kitchen furniture
