

Stephen Sandrichs Sr. Will

In the name of God Amen I Stephen Sandrichs of the County of Ashe & state of N.C. being of sound mind & knowing that all men must die, & as to what property that has pleased God to bless me in this life I desire to & do make the following disposition of all my Estate both real & personal to wit: I give & bequeath to my son Stephen Sandrich all my lands that I own to be his right & property after my death and he is not to have any part of my personal property I wish & desire that my wife Jane if she is alive at my death to have my house & those that I live in and the lot of land & garden around the houses her lifetime, if she chooses, to reside there also that she have a child's part of all my personal property and should not use it all during her life it is to be divided among all my children except Stephen at her death.

I wish & bequeath all the balance of my personal estate after my death to be equally divided among all my children or their heirs, Stephen & Polly who is dead excepted.

I constitute and appoint my son Stephen my Executor to see that my property and effects be faithfully disposed of according to the above bequests. In testimony whereof I have set my hand & affix my seal the 8th day of March 1850
