We have viewed and appraised the Homestead of the said J. R. Bledsoe, and the buildings dwellings and building thereon, owned and occupied by said J. R. Bledsoe, as a Homestead to be worth One thousand dollars, and that the tract, bounded as follows: On the East by the lands of R. A. Farrington, on North by the lands of John Bare, on the West by the lands of A. F. Walsh, on the South by the lands of W. R. Crann is therefore exempted from sale under execution, according to law. At the same time and place we viewed and

appraised, at the values annexed, the following articles of personal property selected by said appraisers, Five cattle valued \$125. Six sheep value \$50. 2 Hogs value \$12. Vehicles, tools etc \$25⁰⁰, Household & Kitchen furniture, Provisions & \$100⁰⁰. Total Personal property \$312⁰⁰ which we declare to be a fair valuation, and that said articles are exempt under said execution.

We hereby certify that we are not related by blood or marriage to the judgment debtor or the judgment creditor in this execution, and have no interest near or remote in the above exemptions.
