

Wills Blevins Sr. Will

I wills. Blevins Sen^r. of the County of Ashe
and State of North Carolina, being now
sound in mind and knowing that
it is appointed for all men to die, have
humbly made and confirmed this my last
Will and Testament as mentioned below, viz.

I bequeath and give unto the three
sons of James Blevins, Jackson, David and
Pomdexter (who are my Grandsons) all and
singular. the lands that I said Wills Blevins
now own in the County aforesaid, and
the said bequeath to commence after the
death of me and my wife, and all my just
debts are paid, with the following provis
that the said James Blevins and his wife are
to have possession of all the aforesaid lands
during their natural life with the provi
sion of cultivating the same to their own
use, & behoof which provis is to commence
after the death of said Wills Blevins & his
wife, & I Wills Blevins do hereby constitute
and appoint the aforesaid James Blevins
my lawful Executor & I said Wills Blevins
Sr. do further bequeath all the goods
& chattels that remain after my. & my. wife's
deatc. to be equally divided among all
my heirs. I also hereby acknowledge the
above to be my last will & Testament given
under my hand this 27th August 1840.

The above is acknowledged
by Wills Blevins Sr. in the
presence of us who also
certify that every instrument
with every appearance
belonging to the above lands
are in order.
