In the name of God Amen. I Zebodue Wyatt of the County of Leno and State of North Carolina being at this time as sound in memory & mind as I ever am. I do this the 27th day of July 1851. Make this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows. I give unto my wife Polly Wyatt. all my lands including my home tract & also my Alexander Mulkey Tracts, of land to be her own rite & title and to dispose of as she may think best. and her title shall be valid & lawful in law. I also give to my wife Polly Wyatt. all my live stock property and all my farming tools. together with all my household furniture. I also give to my wife Polly Wyatt. all my Grain & Bacon on hand with all my standing crops that I have now on hand & also my saddle saddle Bags. my Rifle gun & my Bus my still & Hogsheads together with my leather that is now in law & all my notes judgments and out standing accounts out of which all my just debts is to be settled & I also wish that my wife Polly Wyatt. give to my children to the amount of two Dollars each out of the above property as they come of age. I hereby constitute & appoint Daniel Jones & John McMillan my executors of this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the 27th day of July 1851.
