I Griffin Floyd Senr of Beaufort County in the Province of North Carolina Planter, being at this time Sickly in Body but by the blessing of God of sound mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following. Viz. First I recommend my Soul to the God of Mercy hoping for salvation through Christ my Redeemer, and I hereby desire my Body to be decently Interred by my Executors hereinafter mentioned my worldly Goods I dispose of as follows

Imps I give to my son Peter Floyd my manor Plantation which I now live upon with all its appurtenances and it is my will that he take possession thereof immediately at my decease and the same I do warrant to him and his heirs forever. All my other Estate real or Personal I give my Household Goods Tools of Husbandry and every thing else I own I give to be equally divided between my two sons John & Peter Floyd after my lawfull debts are first paid, and it is my desire that if my said Children should not agree in the Division of my sd Estate that then and in that case they shall indifferently chuse two honest men to make the sd Division and submit to their judgments therein and I do hereby appoint my said two sons John & Peter Floyd Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoke all former Wills and declare this to be my last In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand & Seal this 27th of March 1758

North Carolina In the name of God amen. I James Beaufort County Wall being of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. First I Recommend my Soul to Almighty God and my body to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter to be named and as to my worldly Goods whereof I am possessed I give and bequeath in manner and form following (Viz) - I Give the use and occupation of this my plantation whereon I now live it is all of land with it Corn growing thereon that is now Inclosed unto my loving wife Elizabeth Wall during her widowhood Item I give and Bequeath to my Son James Wall the plantation it was my Brother Robert Wall with all the Lands adjoining thereto and likewise this my manor plantation after the Death or marriage of my loving Wife Elizabeth Wall which shall first happen to him and his heirs. Likewise five Cows and Calves Besides 1st Cattle that are always called his likewise one young mare and one Gun namely 1st gun it was Robert Wall and one Sword and one Small Iron pot and one feather and furniture and one pewter Dish and three pewter plates and one oval Table and one bible and one Testament and one prayer book to him my sd Son and his heirs Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Wall two hundred and twenty acres of land on bear Creek of plantation whereon Rich and Ordeal Dwells and likewise forty pounds proclamation money now in the hands of the Executors of Richard Grish Senr Deceased, and my Will and Desire is if the Executors hereafter named purchase a negro Girl for my said daughter with the money whenever it is paid such a one as the money will purchase to her my said daughter and her heirs. Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Moses Wall the plantation whereon the widow Phillips now Dwells containing one hundred acres of land and one feather bed to him my said Son & his heirs - Item it is my will and Desire if the plantation whereon my Brother Robert Wall Dwelt that is bequeathed to my Son James Wall be rented out with his Stock of Cattle thereon with the ferry and flatt and canoes and all Conveniences for keeping said ferry and the profits arising thereby to be applyed toward the Schooling of my said Son James and to continue so rented out untill my Executors shall think him capable of acting for himself Item it is my will and Desire that my loving wife Elizabeth
