Item I Give to my Son William Tripp a Plantation lying on the South Dividing Creek and all the Land I have Below a Gut and Swamp known by the Name of Dublin with all Buildings and Appurtenances thereunto belonging to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Son Henry Tripp all the Land I own on the South Dividing Creek above the aforesaid Gut called Dublin including the fork to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Son John Tripp after my Wife's Death this Plantation and Land I now live on and all the buildings and Appurtenances to the same belonging to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Son William one Negro boy named Tobey to him and his heirs forever

Item I give to my Son John my Negro man Toney after my Wife's Death to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Daughter Sarah one Negro Girl named Tenny to her and her heirs forever

Item I Give to my Daughter Ann one Negro Girl named Grace to her and her heirs forever

Item I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth one Negro named Sue to her and her heirs forever

Item I Give my Son Henry one Negro Girl named Hannah to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Son John After my Wife's Death the aforesaid Negro named Hannah to him and his heirs forever

Now my Will and Desire is that if the aforesaid Negro Woman named Hannah should have a child or Children from the above Date till my Wife's Death I give them all to my Son Henry to him and his heirs forever. and after my Wife's Death my Will and Desire is that my Cattle should be Equally Divided among all my Children but I would have all my Children that bear any Cattle in their own marks to take them in part of their Share and after my Wife's Death my Will and Desire is that all my Household Goods and Furniture and Horses and Sheep and Dogs be Equally Divided amongst all my Children viz William John Henry Sarah Ann and Elizabeth Tripp

Item I Give to my Son John my own hunting Gun

and I Do hereby constitute and Appoint my well beloved Wife and James Hudson Executor and Executor to this my last Will and Testament

Also I give and bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Brooks all and Every of my goods and Chattles also my wearing apparel

I Do make constitute ordain and appoint to this my Last Will and Testament my Sister Elizabeth Brooks to be my whole and sole Executor. in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Sixteenth Day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty Six
