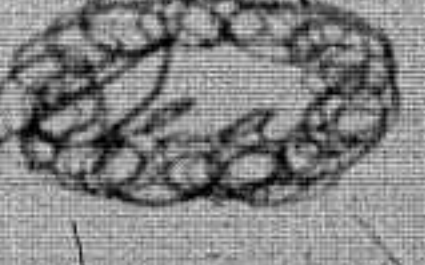

And I constitute and ordain my only and sole Executors of this my last will and testament Seth Pelkinton, William Adams and James Cooper and hereby I do revoke and disannul all and every other former testaments, wills, legacies and executors by me in any way before the time named willed and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

Imprimis. I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Whitcomb all my worldly substance and sole Executors of all my cows, horses and land she paying all my debts, as witness my hand and seal yet day and year above written.
