Bead to each of my Singels Daughters at my Wife exen cutting
my Daughter Elebeth Pusser and also my Daughter Lukea beat
lon off with Shillom Starlan and as for my horses and beatesse
I leave for the good of the family

Beaufort County Being Sick and Weak Do make this my last
Will and Testament In manner and form as followeth

I beid unto my loving wife Mary Welch during her life Estate
both Real and Personal During her life or widowhood which
shall first Happen and at her Death or Marriage I give my Pla
ntation whereon I now live to my Son William Welch to him
and his Heirs forever Provided that my said son should die
without Heir then the said Plantation to go to my Grandson
Jno Clifford and his Heirs provided he lives to the age Twenty one
years and in case he dies before he comes to that age then the
said Plantation to go to the oldest male child of my five
Daughters to wit Elizabeth Jeter Mary Susanna and Irene my

Will is further that at the Death or marriage of my wife that
all the Rest of my Estate be equally Divided between my son
and five Daughters before mentioned Except my Hand mill
and new Saddle which I give to my Son William over and above
his Equal share I also appoint my son in law James Clifffert my
Sole Extr of this my Last Will and Testament

One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Eight, In the Name of
God Amen I James of the County and province aforesaid being
Sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for
it Therefore Calling To mind the Mortality of my body and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to Die I Do therefore make
and Ordain This my Last Will and Testament in manner and form
following Viz that is to say first of all and Principally I Recomme
nd my Soul to the Hands of God that Gave it and as for my Body I
recommmend To the Earth to be Buried in a Christian Like and Decent
manner at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting but at Gen
eral Resurrection I shall receive the Same again through the mighty
power of God and as Touching such Worleay Goods wherewith I
hath pleased God to bless me with in this Life I Give and Divide in
manner and form following Viz

Item I Give unto my Son James Bond all that tract or parcell of Land
that is called the beverdani fork to him and his heirs forever
Item I Give to my Son Abraham Bond this Plantation where I now
live and all the Land belonging to it my beloved wife having the Use
of it During her widowhood and then to my Son Abraham him and
his heirs forever

Item I Give to my Son Ezbona that Land I had of John Herring
lon call the Stamping place and Likewise that Piece of Land on
the South Dividing Creek call the Tern landing to him and
