I Peter Pritchett being sick & weak in Body but of Perfect mind & memory thank be to God therefore calling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner and form following Viz.

As to my Soul I recommend it to the hands of God that gave it Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again through the Mighty Power of God, and as to my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like & decent Manner at the Discretion of my Exrs and as to touching such Worldly Goods as it hath Pleased God to bless me with in this Life I give & devise in Manner following Viz.

Item I do hereby lend to my beloved wife the Manner Plantation during her Life it is my desire that my beloved wife should have the use of my whole Personal Estate during her Life. it is my Desire that when my Son Peter Arrives to the years of Twenty one, that the Increase of my Negro wench named Kae should be Equally Divided Between all my Children Item I give and Bequeath to my Son Abraham a certain Tract

of Land Commonly known by the Name of the first or second Gut to him & his Heirs forever

Item I give & Bequeath to my Son Peter the Manner Plantation to him and his Heirs forever

Item It is my Desire that after the death of my beloved wife that my whole Personal Estate should be Divided Between my Children as follows. Between my Daughter Margaret, my Son Abraham, my Son Peter, my Daughter Sarah, my Daughter Mary & my Daughter Grace to them & their Heirs forever

I do hereby appoint my beloved friend Phillip Pritchett Esq & my beloved wife Exrs of this my Last Will & Testament Signed Sealed & Published in Presence of

This Will was proved by Thos Evans in this Manner He being first sworn in Court deposed that Peter Pritchett within named in his lifetime & last sickness desired him to write his will which he did by direction of the said Peter in the Manner as herein Expressed & when he had wrote the same he delivered it to the said Peter who Read it & approved of the same and he believed the reason it was not signed at that time there wanted witnesses to be present
