Item I give and Bequeath all & singular the remainder of my Estate to be Equally Divided between my wife Mary Phillips my Sons John Phillips, Henry Phillips, William Phillips, & Isaac Phillips, my Daughters Elizabeth Phillips, Anne Phillips and Sarah Phillips, to them and their Heirs forever.

And last of all I nominate and constitute and appoint my beloved friend Henry Bonner to be my Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament

Item I Give unto my Son William Roe fifty Pounds Procs and one feather Bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

Item I Give unto my Daughter Agnes Foote one Walnut Table and Twenty Pounds out of the money that is Due from Mr Ormond when Recovered

Item I Give unto my Son Colman Roe the Remainder Part of my Estate that is not before Given. I also appoint my Son Colman Roe my Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In witness I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Thirteenth Day of Oct^r 1770
