Item I give and Bequeath all Singular the remainder of my Estate  
to be Equally Divided between my Wife Mary Phillips my Sons John  
Phillips, Henry Phillips, William Phillips, & Isaac Phillips, my Daughter  
Elizabeth Phillips, Ann Phillips and Sarah Phillips, to them and their  
Heirs forever.

And last of all I nominate and constitute and appoint my beloved  
friend Henry Bommer to be my Sole Executor of this my Last Will  
and Testament

Item I Give unto my Daughter Agnes Foeten one Walnut Table and Twenty  
Pounds out of the money that is Due from Mr Ormond when Recovered

Item I Give unto my Son Colman Roe the Remainder Part of my Estate  
that is not before Given. I also appoint my Son Colman Roe my Sole  
Exatr of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness I have hereunto set my
