constitute this my Last Will and Testament in manner following.
That is to say. Principally and first of all. I recommend my Soul
to God that gave it, and my Body I Commit to the Earth to be
Buried in a decent Christian manner according to the Discretion
of my Executor nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God, and
as touching and concerning all such Worldly Estate as it hath
pleased God to Bless me with in this Life I give Devise and Be-
queath The same in manner following

Inprimis I give and Bequeath to my well beloved friend Es-
ter Grosley all my whole Estate only Ten Pounds Sterling and
to be laid out at the Discretion of my Executor for his youngest

Child Beith " or female. Likewise I appoint and ordain
my True and Trusty friend John Boyd Esq at Broad Creek
to be whole and Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testa-
ment Revoking and Disannulling all former Wills and Testa-
ments made by me in any form or manner. In Witness wh-
ere of I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fifteenth Day
of October - 1765

God to Bless me with in this Life I give and Devise in manner
and form as follows viz

Item I lend the use of this Plantation and Land now
live on to my wife During her natural Life and the Use of
Two negros. Known by ye name of Tony and Hannah
During her life. Likewise I give the Use of my Horse and
all my Utensils for husbandry During her life and I likewise
Lend to Sa Beloved Wife the Use of all my Cattle that is in
my proper mark During her life and I likewise Lend to
my Beloved Wife the use of all my Sheep or hogs During
