Item 2 I give to my grandson Benjamin Fitzgerald
the first becoming negroes, Mike, Moses, Adam, and Mary
with her future increase, to be delivered to him when
he arrives to the age of twenty one to him and his
heirs and assigns forever.

Item 3 I give and bequeath unto my grand son Edward
Lawrence McKee, one negro male named, Nora
with her present and future increase to be del-
ivered to him at the age of twenty one, whether
less if my grand son, Lawrence, McKee should die
before he arrives at the age of twenty one, the said
Negro Woman and, her present and future increase shall
return and be divided among my three children -
Edward, Quetz, and Gained.

Item 4 I give and bequeath unto my grand son Benjamin
Randolph White, one negro girl named, Nancy, the
daughter of Mary, nevertheless if my grand son
Benjamin Randolph White should die before
he arrives to the age of twenty one, the said girl,
Nancy, be given to my daughter Gained.

Item 5 I give to my son in law, James, McKee, first
Shillings Sterling.

Item 6 I give to my daughter Quetz, the following negroes
Joe Cook, Adam, with her present and future increase
along with her future increase, Jenn, with her present
and future increase to her the said Quetz, her heirs
and assigns forever.

Item 7 I give to my daughter Gained the following negroes
Charv, Ben, and Mary, with her present and future
increase, Nancy excepted, also also with her pres-
ent and future increase to her the said Gained and
heirs and assigns forever.

I do hereby constitute and appoint Edwards
Fitz Randolph, Malcom McKee, and George
Knox, my true and lawful Executors of this
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and
disannulling all other former Wills by me made

Will and Testament.
