IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN:— I, Eliza Bond Guthrie, being
of sound mind and disposing memory and
discretion, but Considering the uncertainty of
this earthly life, and mindful of the certainty
of death, do make establish, ordain, publish
and declare this to be my last will and
testament, in manner and form following:
First.— I desire that my body shall receive
Christian burial, and I direct my executors
hereinafter named to provide for the same
out of my estate.

Second.— I desire all my just debts of any
nature whatsoever to be paid by my executors
and direct that so much of my property,
real or personal as shall be necessary be
applied to their discharge.

Third.— I give, devise and bequeath unto my grand
daughter, Elizabeth Price wife of Captain Jesse D.
Price, all my right, title, interest and estate in
and to a certain lot, piece or parcel of land
lying and being in the town of Southport, County
and State aforesaid, and particularly described
as follows: A portion of Lot No 66 in the plan of
the said town, being in length 33 feet and in
breadth 66 feet, and being the lot wherein Mrs
Amelia Ann Guthrie has resided and does now
reside. Also all personal property belonging to
me at the time of my death.

Fourth.— I do nominate, constitute and appoint
my beloved grand-daughter, Elizabeth Price as
aforesaid, the sole executrix of this my last
will and testament, hereby revoking and making
null and void any and all Wills by me here-
tofore made.

In witness whereof, I, the said Eliza Bond Guthrie
do hereunto set my hand and seal, this 11th day
of February, in the year of our Lord, one thousand
Nine Hundred and One.
