First, all my just debts & funeral expenses shall be first fully paid.

Second, I give bequeath, & devise my acres & tracts of land to my daughter Salaria Jones, or her heirs, excepting two acres for Helen Jones, where she now lives, her natural life, then said two acres to pass to my daughter Salaria Jones.

I give my wife Eliza Goodman a life time right to all the residue of my personal & real property, that is I clearly mean that she shall have full & entire control of said personal & real property, to sell any of the personal she chooses but she shall not sell any of the real estate.

At the death of my wife Eliza Goodman then & she that all my property the residue thereof shall be equally divided between my son Charles Goodman & my daughter Salaria Jones, or their heirs.

Third, I nominate & appoint William H. Walker to be executor of this my last & testament, hereby revoking all former wills made by me.
