I John H. White, of the Town of Charlotte, County of Brunswick and State of North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, to-wit:

1 First- All my just debts (if any) and funeral expenses shall be first fully paid; this to include a suitable gravestone to mark my grave, costing about one hundred and fifty dollars.

2 Second- I give, devise and bequeath unto my daughter Jane M. Stanley and the heirs of her body, the following tracts or parcels of land, to-wit:

First lot begin on the South side of the Georgetown road at J. T. White's corner runs thence with his line to Charlotte river thence down said river just far enough to make a five acre lot, by running a parallel line with first mentioned line. This lot to contain just five acres, and to include buildings of my present home. Also another lot on the North side of said road adjoining the Wiley Leonard lands and the lands of J. M. White and L. C. Triff. Being the same on which my barns and stables now stand. Also one acre lot adjoining the lands of J. L. Hewitt on the East and the lands of Cornelia Hewitt on the North, together with the store building now occupied by U. G. White.

3 Third-- The balance of my homestead, known as the West house lying and being on the South side of the said Georgetown road between the lot just described which I give to Jane M. Stanley on the west, Charles Branch on the east and the river on the South, I wish divided into three equal shares or so lots: said lots to be laid out from said road to river until Charles Branch is reached, thence thenceforth from the said road to said Branch, all lines to run parallel with first or third White line.

4 Fourth-- To each of my children (exclusion of J. M. Stanley) also to the living heirs of my daughter Sarah S. Holmes namely, Willie Holmes and Coralia Pearl Edwards, I give one lot each, except as to the Holmes heirs they shall have one lot jointly; viz: H. T. White one lot; Malina Belle Stanley one lot; Harriet White one lot; Mary G. Williams one lot; also one lot Anne M. Gore, one lot U. Grant White, one lot (this to be the same on which his house now stands) Rebecca Russ one lot, and the said Willie Holmes and Coralia Pearl Edwards one lot.

5 Fifth-- My big store lot, I give to Martin L. White and U. Grant White jointly; provided they pay to Rebecca Russ the sum of three hundred dollars.

6 Sixth-- My new store and lot adjoining the store lot which I have given to Jane M. Stanley, and lying between said lot and Cornelia Hewitt's lane or right of way, I give to Anne M. Gore, provided she pay to Rebecca Russ the sum of one hundred dollars.

7 Seventh-- The lot lying and being on the North side of Main Street adjoining the lands of the said Cornelia Hewitt on the North and East, and the lot of H. T. White on the west I wish divided: giving one half to A. Gray, and the other half to the children of Sarah S. Holmes viz: Willie Holmes and Coralia Pearl Edwards.

8 Eighth-- My little lot lying on the west side of and adjoining the Park lot I give unto Malina Belle Stanley.

9 Ninth-- My tract of land known as "The Camp Hewitt place" and which contains about twelve acres, I wish divided in half running the lines in an east and west direction as my Administration shall determine, establishing a well defined line: the land on the North side of this line I give to the two children of Margaret Simmons viz: Bruce Simmons and Pearl Simmons.

10 Tenth-- I leave unto Chapel Hill Baptist Church for maintenance and repair, the sum of one hundred dollars: but this fund shall remain in the hands of my Administrators until actually paid out for said repairs as needed from time to time until the above specified amount shall have been expended.

11 Eleventh-- I nominate and appoint my son Martin L. White and my son-in-law John A. Stanley to be the executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills by me made.
