Kathaniel Little being of sound mind and memory but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say That my Executor, (hereinafter named,) shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends, and pay all funeral expenses to settle with my just debts hereunder and to whomsoever may come out of the money that may first come into his hands, as a part or parcel of my Estate.

I give and devise to my beloved wife Georgiana P. Little (25) acres land two hundred and fifty two acres of land all of my improvements on the above mentioned land including my mansion house all out houses and other improvements to have and to hold to her the said Georgiana P. Little for and during the term of her natural life and satisfaction for and in lieu of her donee and thirds of and in all my real estate.

I give and bequeath to my said beloved wife Georgiana P. Little (2) two slaves one about fourteen years old the other about five years old, also I give to my wife (30) twenty head of cattle also I give to my wife (30) thirty five head of sheep, also I give to my wife (30) thirty head of hogs also I give to my wife (30) ten bushels of corn, also all my beds and Furniture also all my house hold and Kitchen Furniture, all my plantation tools carts, plows and hoes and all parts of them also I give to my beloved wife Georgiana Little all my Domestic poultry also I give to my wife (30) thirty dollars in Cash to her use and benefit During her life, and after her death all and Every part of the real Estate and personal property of Every kind mentioned in this my last will in manner and form, I give and Devise to my Brother Jessie H. Little after the Death of my wife Georgiana P. Little Every part of all the property to my Brother Jessie H. Little and to his use & benefit for Ever, And further I do hereby nominate and appoint my trusty friends and stepsons Christopher Little my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes, to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every Part and, clause thereof hereby making and declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments by me before made, In witness whereof I the said Kathaniel Little do hereunto set my hand and Seal this the 9 day of December AD 1879. Signed sealed published and declared by the said Kathaniel Little to be his last will and testament, in the presence of us who, at his request and in his presence do subscribe our names as witnesses thereto

And this deponent further saith, that at the said time when the said testator subscribed his name to said last will as aforesaid, and at the time of the deponent's subscribing his name as an attesting witness thereto, as aforesaid, the said Kathaniel Little was of sound mind and memory, of full age to execute a will, and was not under any restraint, to the knowledge, information or belief of this deponent. And further this deponent say not.
