Moore of the County of Brunswick in the State of North Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and having full knowledge of what I own and possess, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, in manner and form following and none other, that is to say:-

Item, 1. My executor hereinafter named shall give my body and decent burial according and suitable to the wishes and desires of my friends and relatives and pay all funeral expenses, together with all my just debts out of the first monies coming into their hands by virtue of their office belonging to my estate.

Item, 2. I give, and bequeath all of my personal property of whatsoever kind and nature and wheresoever situate to my children Inez Moore Alexander, Edna Moore Latham, James Moore, Eugene Moore, Wallace Moore, Joel L. Moore and Claude Moore, to be equally divided among them, share and share alike and in the event of the death of any of my said children prior to my death, then such share shall go to the heirs at law of such deceased child to be equally divided among said heirs at law of such deceased child, share and share alike, I have heretofore made gifts or advancements to my said children but I consider these matters concluded and complete so that no gift or advancement shall be charged against any of my said children and they shall not be required to account to each other for any gift or advancement heretofore made by me.

Item, 3. I give, devise and bequeath all of my real estate wheresoever situate, to my children as named in Item No. 2, hereof, whether within or without the State of North Carolina, to be equally divided among them, share and share alike, and in the event of the death of any of my said children prior to my death then such share shall go to the heirs at law of such deceased child to be equally divided among said heirs at law of such deceased child, share and share alike. In the event an equal division of my real estate cannot be made without injury to some of the shares as herein provided, then my executor hereinafter named are authorized and directed to sell the same either at public or private sale at such time or times and place or places as they may deem best, and execute proper conveyances therefor and the proceeds of such sale or sales shall be divided equally among my said children, share and share alike, and in the event of the death of any of my said children prior to my death then such share shall go to the heirs at law of such deceased child to be equally divided among such heirs at law of such deceased child, share and share alike, as provided for the division of my real estate in this item.

Item, 4. I hereby constitute and appoint my son, Joel Moore as my true and lawful executor, without bond, to execute this my last will and testament according to its true intent and meaning, and every part and clause thereof, hereby revoking and declaring utterly null and void any and other wills heretofore made by me.
