Second:- I will and devise my land on Eagles Island as follows: One-half interest to Daniel R. Johnson, one-sixth interest each to Frances J. Sawyer, Alice J. Sawyer and Daniel R. Sawyer.

Third:- I will and bequeath all the live stock on my plantation, including horses, mules, cattle, hogs, etc., as follows: one-half interest to Daniel R. Johnson, one-sixth interest each to Frances J. Sawyer, Alice J. Sawyer and Daniel R. Sawyer.

Fourth:- I will and bequeath all my property, real, personal or mixed, not hereinbefore otherwise devised or bequeathed, to my nieces, Frances J. Sawyer and Alice J. Sawyer.

I hereby appoint and designate my sister, Alice J. Sawyer, Executrix of this my last will and Testament.

In testimony whereof, I, the said Sarah Amanda Russell, have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14th day of November, 1911.
