A Paper purporting to be the last will and testament of Hugh Pinner deceased is exhibited before me the undersigned Judge of Probate for said County, Leander Pinner the executor there in named, and the due execution thereof, Wm Brown, and Robert Green, the subscribing witnesses thereto, who being duly sworn do each depose and say and each for him self depose and sayeth, that he is a subscribing witness to the paper writing now shown him purporting to be the last will and testament of Hugh Pinner, that the said Hugh Pinner in the presence of this deponent subscribed his name at the end of said paper writing, which bears date on the 28th day of January A D 1869, And the deponent further sayeth that the said Hugh Pinner, the testator aforesaid did at the time of subscribing his name as aforesaid, declared the said paper writing so subscribed by him, and as he beated to be his last will and testament, and this deponent did thereupon, subscribe his name at the end of said will as attesting witness thereto, and at the request and in the presence of the said Testator

And this deponent further sayeth that at the said time when the said Testator subscribed his name to the said last will as aforesaid and at the time of the deponent subscribing his name an attesting witness thereto as aforesaid the said Hugh Pinner, was of sound mind and memory of full age to execute a will, and was not under any restraint to the knowledge of information or belief of this deponent, and further these deponent sayeth that Wm Brown sworn & subscribed Robert Green sworn & subscribed before me J. R. R.

In the name of God, Amen,
I Adam Eller of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be God, do this 20th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and forme following viz

I am first

My three sons Adam H. William C. and John C. have each received their portion and hence I bequeath them nothing more than my blessing.

I am second

To my daughter Eliza Hot I will and bequeath that part of a tract of land granted to John Willard lying West of the ball mountain Road beginning at the north east corner of the Fresh field known as the Jenkins field and running a north westerly course with my line to the North corner of said field then South to the South line of said tract

I am third

To my daughter Christina Rice I will and bequeath all that part of my land lying west of the bequeath in the preceding item

I am fourth

To my daughter Martha Patton and Rebecca Eller I will and bequeath the tract of land on which the said Martha Patton now resides each to have an equal share

I am fifth

I will and desire that my personal property be equally divided between my four daughters after my eldest son receive the value of of twenty five dollars said son Joseph P. Eller having heretofore received the part intended for him

I desire that my two sons William C. Eller and John C. Eller, act as executors of this my last will & testaments, believing they will strictly observe my bequests this 4th day of November A D 1870
