

# The Last Will and Testament of B J Smith

I, B J Smith of the City of Asheville  
in the County of Buncombe and State  
of North Carolina, considering the sure  
certainty of life and the certainty of death  
and being of a sound and disposing mind  
and memory, do make, publish and  
declare this to be my last will and  
testament.

- 1<sup>st</sup>) I desire my Executor hereinafter  
named, to pay out of my estate all  
my Medical bills and funeral expenses
- 2<sup>nd</sup>) I give and bequeath all my property of  
every kind and description to my five  
daughters, Emma Clayton wife of  
Thomas L Clayton, Kate Brown widow  
of the late Marcus Erwin, Hannah M  
Davidson widow of Edward Davidson  
deceased, Jessie H Lydger wife of  
H A Lydger, Sallie Robinson wife of  
Marcus W Robinson and my two sons  
Lucas Smith and David Smith to be  
~~equally~~ divided equally between them  
Share and share alike
- 3<sup>rd</sup>) My sons, Horace and Adolphus Smith having  
already been advanced by me what I can  
their share of my estate, it is my desire  
and will that they receive no further part  
of my estate
- 4<sup>th</sup>) I hereby nominate and appoint H A  
Lydger the sole executor of this my last  
will and testament, revoking all former  
wills by me made, In testimony whereof  
I, B J Smith have hereunto set my  
hand and seal this the second day of  
September 1885

and which bears date of the 2nd day of September  
1885. And the deponent further saith that the said  
B J Smith the testator aforesaid, did at the time  
of subscribing his name as aforesaid, declare the  
said paper writing so subscribed by him and  
exhibited, to be his last will and testament and  
this deponent did thereupon subscribe his name  
at the end of said will as an attesting witness thereto,  
and at the request and in the presence of the  
said testator. And this deponent further saith  
that at the said time when the said testator  
subscribed his name to the said last will as  
aforesaid, and at the time of deponents, subscri-  
bing his name as an attesting witness thereto  
as aforesaid, the said B J Smith was of sound  
mind and memory, of full age to execute a will  
and was not under any restraint to the knowledge  
of information or belief of this deponent, and further this
