and bequeath in the following manner

First I give to my son William Lafayette Foster now about four years old
Eight Hundred Dollars out of my estate in consequence of his present situation
Secondly I give to my beloved wife Luanda the tract of land wherein
I now live & the adjoining lands excepting the Presby & Down places during
her natural life and at her death to descend to my two children Mary Ann
Foster & William Lafayette Foster

Thirdly I wish and desire the balance of my property both real and personal
be equally divided with my beloved wife and my two before mentioned
children share & share alike each one third I hereby constitute and
appoint James Quigley my executor & my beloved wife Luanda my executrix
of this my last will & testament

Eight Hundred & forty two make & ordain this my last will & testament
I do leave & bequeath my furnishable property such as my wife Martha now
but spare to be sold as will pay all my just debts

2nd I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha all the land which I now
own with the full benefit of all the buildings and farm as her own right and property
during her life time or until my three Sons Thomas Evans & Joshua & Rufus shall
arrive to the full age of Twentyone years at which time all the land is to belong
to them but if my wife should live longer than the time of their coming to the age of
Twentyone years she is to have her maintenance of the land during her life
further bequeath unto my wife Martha All of my furnishable property of all kinds
she should exception during her life at her death all the property except the land
to be equally divided amongst All of my children then living

such sums as one can spare to them so as to make as equal a distribution as
possible amongst them

And I do hereby constitute and ordain my trustee friend Joshua Whitaker
Executor to this my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have

I Brady Powers of the County of Buncombe & State of North Carolina being

testament and principally and first of all I do recommend my soul into the
hands of God that gave it and as for my body I recommend it to the Earth

Nothing Doubting but that I shall receive the same again by the Mighty
of God and as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
bless me in this life I do give devise and dispose of the same in the following
and form

In witness I do leave to Sarah Powers my well Beloved Wife with all my house
hold Goods and Furniture and Movable effects with house Cattle and Hogs all
During her Natural life or widowhood and at her death or Marriage the
whole to be disposed of in the following manner and form I do Give and
bequeath unto William Powers my beloved Son all the land possessed by me
on the East side of White Creek I do give and bequeath to Asenar Powers my
well Beloved Son all my land lying on the West side of White Creek
During their Natural life and then to the heir of their bodies and all the
rest of my Estate with my Stock and Movable effects to be Equally divided
between my three Sons and two Daughters and I hereby constitute and
appoint Joseph Miller and James Jones my two Substitutes Executrix
of this my last will and testament and I do hereby attorney Revokes
and cancel all and Every other former will and testament by me
this day of July 1833 testifying and confirming this and no other to be

Obdiah Holcombe last will and testament

In the name of God Amen I Obdiah Holcombe of the County of Buncombe
and State of Carolina being afflicted and weak in body but of perfect
Mind and Memory calling unto mind the Mortality of my body and Knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last
will and testament and as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal it has pleased
God to bless me with in this life I Give devise and dispose of in the following
manner and form

1st I give and bequeath to my beloved Sons & daughters the heirs of the body of
my first wife as follows First, Henry, Elizabeth, Alice, Peggy, Obdiah, Richard,
James, Ning, Charles, Cynthia, Elizabey and fourth Holcombe the sum of one
Dollar each with the exception of Alice and I give to him the sum of four Dollars
it being about the amount that he owes me besides what they have heretofore
Received of my Estate

2nd I give to my Grand Son Henry Holcombe the House that he has heretofore
Received and got in possession

3rd I also give and bequeath to Miller my present and only beloved wife the sum
of Ten Dollars

4th I give to my two daughters heirs of the body of my last wife above the sum of one
Dollar each all of which sum to be paid over to her out of my Estate

5th I also give and bequeath to my three Sons, James & John & Obdiah Holcombe
all of the balance of my Estate Both Real and personal Share & Share Alike

6th It is my will that my present wife Continue to live on my land after my Death
during her widowhood of the choice to do so but if she marries again not attend that
liberty

7th It is also my will that my Executor shall have the sole Control and Management
of my four Eldest Children heirs of the body of my present **Buncombe Co. NC Wills 1831 to 1868**

8th It is also My will that my Executor after my death take possession of my Estate

9th I also Constitute Make and ordain Henry H. Holcombe and John Doney the sole
Executors of this my last will and testament Ratified and confirm this and
No other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this twelfth day of August in the Year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred & forty one Sigma Seals published pronouned
and adscribed by the same Obdiah Holcombe as his last will and testament in the
presence of us who have hereunto Subscribed our Names
