

The last will & Testament of Edmund Foster

In the Name of God Amen

I Edmund Foster of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina
Being sick and feeble in body though sound in mind and calling to mind
the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for men once
to die do make and constitute this my last will and testament that is
to say first I command my soul to Almighty God who gave it and my
body to a decent Christian burial at the direction of my executors
And as to my earthly goods with which it hath pleased god to bless me I give
and bequeath in the following manner

First I give to my son William Lafayette Foster now about four years old
Eight Hundred Dollars out of my estate in consequence of his present situation
Secondly I give to my beloved wife Luenda the tract of land wherein
I now live & the adjoining lands excepting the Presby & Dover places during
her natural life and at her death to descend to my two children Mary Anne
Foster & William Lafayette Foster

Thirdly I wish and desire the balance of my property both real and personal
be equally divided with my beloved wife and my two before mentioned
children share & share alike each one third I hereby constitute and
appoint James Quigley my executor & my beloved wife Luenda my executrix
of this my last will & testament

for testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this
24th day of August A.D. 1842

of Buncombe being in a low state of health but in sound mind memory
blessed be God as this 28th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight Hundred & forty two make & ordain this my last will & testament
I do now & sufficingly of处分able property such as my wife Martha can
but spare to be sold as will pay all my just debts

2nd I will & bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha all the land which I now
own with the full benefit of all the buildings and farm as her own right and property
during her life time or until my three sons Thomas Cowin & Joshua & Russell shall
come to the full age of twenty one years at which time all the land is to belong
to them but if my wife should live longer than the time of their coming to the age of
twenty one years she is to have her maintenance of the land during her life
further bequeath unto my wife Martha All of my处分able property of all kinds
should exception during her life at her death

and if I should require she may before her death give to any or all of the children
such things as she can spare to them so as to make an equal distribution as
possible amongst them

And I do hereby constitute and ordain my trustee friend Joshua Whitaker
Executor to this my last will and testament in testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal the day and date above written

Last Will & Testament of Brody Powers

In the Name of God amen this sixteenth day July 1833

I Brody Powers of the County of Buncombe & State of North Carolina being
well in health and in perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same
but calling unto mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is
Appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last will and
testament and principally and first of all I do recommend my soul into the
hands of God that gave it and as for my body I recommend to the earth
to be buried in a decent Christian Manner at the discretion of my executors
Nothing Doubting but that I shall recover the same again by the Mighty
of God and as touching my worldly Estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to
bless me in this life I do give devise and dispose of the same in the following
and manner

Imprimis I do leave to Sarah Powers my well beloved wife with all my house
hold Goods and Furnature and Movable effects with house Cattle and hogs all
During her natural life or widowhood and at her death or marriage the
whole to be disposed of in the following manner and form I do give and
bequeath unto William Powers my beloved son all the land possessed by me
and East side of White Creek I do give and bequeath to Stephen Powers my
well beloved son all my land lying on the West side of White Creek
During their natural lives and then to the heirs of their bodies and all the
rest of my Estate with my Stock and Movable effects to be Equally divided
between my three Sons and two Daughters and I hereby constitute and
appoint Joseph Miller and James Jones my two Suretains Executors
of this my last will & testament and I do hereby alter by Revoking
all former wills and every other former will and testament I make
