First of All I give & bequeath to my Daughter Polly Alexander, Two hundred & fifty Dollars, To my Daughter Nancy Stevens, Two hundred & fifty Dollars, To my Daughter Manerva C Davidson, Two hundred & fifty Dollars, To my Son Newton Foster, Two hundred & fifty Dollars, Fifthly, Two hundred Dollars to my grand Daughter, Mary Ann Foster, this Two hundred Dollars which I gave to my grand Daughter, Mary Ann Foster Being part of which I intended for her Mother Lucinda Roberts, for which I have seen proper to give her by the consent of her Mother, - In the second place all the Balance of my property Money & Effects that are in my possession at my death, to be equally divided between my Children - I desire and appoint Henry Stevens & W F Davidson, my Executors - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal this 28th day of December 1860

In the name of God Amen;— I, William J Ramsay of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail & transitory life do therefore make, ordain, publish & declare, this to be my last will and testament: That is to say after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged, the residue of my estate, real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of entirely to my lawful wife, all that tract and parcel of land on which I now live, known and described as the Jacob Ramsay Farm lying and being in the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina, together with all my personal property of every grade and species of which I am now or may be possessed of at the time of my death;— Likewise I make constitute and appoint J R Buckner to be my lawful Executor of this my last will & testament In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the twentieth day of August—in the year of our Lord, one thousand Eight hundred and sixty two

A Harrop Will

I Able Harrop of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina Being of sound mind & memory do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament:— First after my death my body to be decently interred all my funeral expenses paid also all my debts paid
 Second; I will to my daughter Peggy Ashworth my Negro Boy Sampson & to my Son Wesley Harrop my Boy Elliott and to my daughter Ann E Davidson my Boy Lewis to them & to their heirs forever; I give to my daughter Susan & her heirs all that tract of land I bought of J W Harrop on the waters of Swannanoa River to her & her heirs forever: Thirdly I will and bequeath to my two youngest sons Abel F Harrop & Thomas J Harrop all my home plantation and all the lands joining including the land, I bought of A Foster to be equally divided between them by dismemberment
 And lastly I bequeath & will to my Wife Elizabeth Harrop my Negro woman Nancy & to have the east end of my house to live in during her life and to be supported equally between my two last named sons in a bountiful manner as she has heretofore lived not wanting for anything necessary to her comfort & of my sons A F & Thomas J Harrop do not except She is to have as much Land layed off to her out of the plantation as will be sufficient for her support. Also I Bequeath to her one Cow and calf of her choice, one two year old heifer, one Peck & Breading, The cupboard and contents The Kitchen furniture I want all my other property sold & equally divided among my heirs, Buncombe Co NC Wills 1831 to 1868
