The Last will & Testament of Francis Gillespie

State of North Carolina Buncombe County

 to the well fare of my family and being in my right
 mind I do this day make this my will, and in the same
 I do bequeath unto my wife Jane Gillespie all my lands
 and all the stock both horse cows best hogs and sheep
 all the farming tools and harness of every kind all the
 house hold and kitchen property also all the debts due
 my both books or notes also stills and vessels also what
 money on hand unto her so long as she shall live or
 remain single and then the property to be sold or divided
 so as to give each child an equal share in valuation
 also make my dear wife Jane Gillespie and John Reynolds
 my administrators on the will above to see to the execution
 of this my will made this twelfth day of April in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty three
