The Last Will & Testament of Hannah Baird

State of N. Carolina

Buncombe County } I Hannah Baird of the County and
State aforesaid being of Sound Mind altho
afflicted, and desirous to make the following disposition of all my
worldly effects between my Children and by these presents make
my Last Will and Testament as follows:

First. I will & bequeath to my three daughters each as follows Mirah
McVance, Sarah A. Smith & Mary A. Baird the girl Cherry
which I give my daughter Mirah McVance has died & I have paid
her for said girl out.

Secondly I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah A.
Smith my negro girl girl Mirah

Thirdly. I give & bequeath unto my daughter
Mary A. Baird my Negro girl Fara. I also will and bequeath unto
my daughter Mary A. Baird the following property to worth two heads
furniture & Trade from the fact I leave my daughter Mary A. Baird
unprotected. I feel it my duty to give her something & therefore
I will her my dear servant Millie.

I further will to all my Sons living
to wit James, C. Baird, Joseph, C. Baird, Adolphus C. Baird & Children of
my Deceased Sons John M. W. Baird, Andrew A. Baird, that my two boys
Landy & Sandy be equally divided among the above named Sons & orphan
children of my Sons above named. That is the Orphan children of each
Son make one sum, & is to have an equal proportion of said negroes I
also wish that my Sons give an share the said negroes without selling
them out of the Family as I never Intended selling the property given me
by my Father in Writing when of I have hereunto set my hand an
Seal in presence of. January the 9th A.D. 1849 Hannah Baird Seal

Will Docket To July Term A.D. 1869
The Last Will & Testament of Henry West Deceased

In the name of God amen I Henry West of the County of Buncombe
and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and
knowing the uncertainty of life do make and publish this my last will
and testament in manner and form following that is to say
First I give and bequeath unto Jane Weller widow and Elsie Hamby
and their heirs both of the County of Buncombe and State aforesaid each
one half of the three following tracts of land lying in the County of
Buncombe and all joining tract first Beginning on a Spanish oak Willow
North East corner thence south crossing the creek with Wilsons line
ninety poles to a Hickory on Henry Wests line thence East with his line
Twenty three poles to a Stake thence North eight poles to Chestnut on the bank
of the creek West beginning corner then East with Wests line crossing the
creek one hundred and forty poles to a black oak passing Wests corner
forty two poles thence North one hundred poles to a white oak on the west
edge of the road thence west one hundred and forty poles to a Stake on Mr
Forsters line thence South with Forsters line twenty poles to a pine
his corner thence west twenty three poles to the beginning containing an
hundred acres entered the 18th December 1830 and granted the 22nd December
1831. Tract second Beginning at a Chestnut tree in a bottom three poles
west of Forgers creek and runs south to a Red oak conditional corner
between Henry West and Daniel Smith thence to the mouth of the little
branch being the North part of a tract granted to Henry West 6th January
1794- containing about sixty or sixty five acres of Tract third.
Beginning on a hickory on Henry Wests old line and runs south one hundred
and eighty poles to a Stake thence west eighty nine poles to a Stake thence
west one hundred and eighty poles thence East eighty nine poles to the beginning
containing one hundred acres granted to Henry West 9th of December 1795 I hereby
appoint Jane Wilson sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament hereby
overlooking all former wills by me made In witness whereof I have here
substant set my hand and seal the 15th day of September 1836
