of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
sixty nine make and publish this my
last will and testament in manner
and forme following viz

John C. have each received their portion
and hence I bequeath them nothing more
than my blessing,

I am second To my daughter Eliza Hop I will and
bequeath that part of a tract of land ~~now~~
given to John Willard lying west of the
ball mountain Road beginning at the

known as the Jenkins field and running
a north westerly course with my line to
to the North corner of said field then South
to the South line of said tract

I am third To my daughter Christina Rice I will and
