State of North Carolina in the name of God amercy Ieasle startis
Buncombe 3 of November being of sound and perfect minde
and memory Helpd by God I do this thirteenth day of
January in the year of 1812 to make and publish this my last will
and testament the general following that is to say I give and bequeath unto
my beloved wife Barbara my plantation where I now live containing
one hundred acres during her life first & faire and bequeath also &
hereby make and ordain my beloved son Joseph Martin junr
Executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the
said Joseph Martin have to this my last will and testament set
my hand and seal the day and year above written signed
Published and Delivrd by the said Joseph Martin testator
as his last will and testament in the presence of us who were
present at the time of laying and sealing thereto

the sum of one dollar each before marriage, now I do hereby
revoke and make void the said Legacies to my sons so
hereby given and bequeath unto my son two sons and two
Daughters above named Nancy Martin Peter Martin
Jackson Martin and Harriet Martin all my Estate at
their mothers Deans over and above The value of the Sons
and Daughters which I have given them by my said will
in witness whereof I have to this bond affixed my hand
and set my hand and seal the 11th day of July 1842

Blessed be God do this 1st of February in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty six make and
publish this my last will and testament in the manner
following that is to say

1st I gave and bequeath to my wife Phoebe a comfortable
Inport for life on the Plantation unless passengers during life
and also my negroes Jimmy & Sam & Henry, Jimmy to be a
Bakery boy and also so much of the Stock as could be
a sufficient Inport during her life and also all the
Households furnitures and to dispose of said house hold
furniture as she thinks proper

7th I also gave a sum bequeath my Negro Girl Jimmy
to my Daughter Rhodes, at my wife's death was also my
Baby James to my Son G. B. and for him to place
one of Esquend's Values or his worth to my Daughter Betsy
at my wife's death was also my Negro Girl Mary I gave
for the use of my Daughter Rachel so long as she remains
in this country and if she removes out of this country
I gave her to my Son G. B. and for him to replace
an other of Esquend's Values and at the death of my
Daughter Rachel I allow said girl and her increase
to be especially provided among her Daughters

Item 3^d and at the Death of my wife I allowe my Lenes to be Salve
and all my Debts paid and the money of the Sale first and I gave
and began witht out of the sale of my Lenes to my Son newton the
first One hundred Dollars and then the balance of the Price
of my Lenes to be equally Dividet between my Sons John &
& Robert L.

Brook & I also gave my Books to my sons John C. & Mr. D.
& Brewster H. to be equally divided between them at the Death
of my wife and all the Stock or horses at the Death of
my wife I leave undivided to my sons Geo. C.
and whereby make and ordain my sons Geo. C & Robert S.
Executors of this my last will and testament in writing
whereof I the said James Blanchard have to this my last
will and testament set my hand and seal this day and
year above written.
