

Will Book A Sept Term AD 1864

In the name of God Amen,  
 I James M Smith of the County of Buncombe  
 and State of North Carolina, being weak & full in  
 body but of sound and disposing mind and  
 memory do make ordain and establish this my  
 last will and testament by items in manner  
 and form following.

Item first, I will that my body be decently interred  
 and my funeral expenses and all other just debts  
 be paid.

Item second I will bequeath & desire that my son  
 Joseph Henry Smith shall have two thirds of all  
 my present real personal & mixed and that  
 the balance be equally divided between my four  
 other children viz Margaret Leah - Martha Hammitt  
 & William Alexander Samuel Lafayette the child  
 of Martha Craig who claims to be my wife - my  
 desire that it shall have no part of my property  
 whatever.

Item third

I will and direct that all my movable  
 property be sold by my executors at public sale  
 either for Cash or on Credit at the discretion of  
 my executors after legal advertisement as soon after  
 my decease as practicable and my real  
 property be rented out by my executors until  
 twelve months after the expiration of the present  
 term this to be sold as above directed and proceed  
 divided as directed in the first & second,

 testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set
