The Last Will and Testament of Jesse Carter Deed

Manupative of Jesse Carter made on the 10th of January 1838 in presence of Thomas Reeves Elizabeth Reeves and Nancy Carter which was as follows he desired was that Thomas Reeves should take care of his ~~children~~ family. He then directed his wife should bring what money he had on hands to be brought out which on being produced in three parcels amounting to six hundred and sixty two dollars & fifty cents which he desired should be put out at Interest for the use of his family. he also desired that the debts owing to him to between two hundred and fifty to three hundred dollars should be made safe and the interest thereof to the use of his family and if any more Interest should arise there was needed specially it was to be given to his wife the principal he wished divided between his children as they came of age giving to Nathan a briple a Larger portion than the rest he being one of the children by his first wife

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Justice Carters will continue

on the 11th of the Same month two day before in presence of
Milly Robert and his wife he told Mr Riley Robert he wished his
wife to have the milk cows and the use of the horses and his hogs
he wished his wife to have the old tract of Land containing one
hundred acres and all the rest of his Land to be sold He wished
Nathan to have a little more than the rest of his children

He also wished all the other cattle to be sold and the money to
be placed at interest and for the Support of his family he also
wished his children to be schooled
