Witnessing the 11th The year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirty four, The following is my
Last will and Testament
Section first

I will and bequeath my Soul to God who gave it,
and my body to the grave, there to be decently entombed
Secondly

I will and bequeath all my property both real and
personal to my wife Susan Case during her natural
life, and at her death, then the lands to go to
Namely my son, in case he takes care of my daughter
Enatitia and long as she lives and in case he fails
to do so, then the Enatitia is to have it to hold
or to be at her own disposal, with the exception of
two pieces of land, to wit; one to Allen Kase
beginning on a stake in my field 4 rods south
of Samuel Speer's stake corner runs east to Baker
line, then with said line to a Spanish oak
then west with Mary's old line to a stake; then
south with Samuel Speer's line to the Beginning
containing fifty acres more or less which he is
to have on condition that he and his case pays a debt

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which I owe To Robert Twitty; and also one other
To Samuel Sperry Beginning on a stake in my
field and runs north fifty six poles to a stake in
Sperrys line; thence west fifty five poles to a stake
in Browns line; thence with Browns line fifty six
poles to a stake on said Sperrys line; thence with
said Sperrys line fifty five poles to the beginning contain
ing twenty acres more or less, which he Samuel
Sperry is to have in case he pays a debt which
I owe to the Bank in Asheville Thirdly
I also appoint William Case executor of this my
last will and testament
