John Meares Last Will and Testament

In the name of God amen I John Meares of the County of Brunswick and State of North Carolina being of sound and disposing mind and memory thank be to god do this tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say

First I give and bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave it first

I severly my body to the Earth to be auncy buried at the discretion of my Executors

Secondly my will and pleasure is that should I decease first that my property personal and Real be kept together with raw is under the care and contrall of my son Montross Meares for the comfortable maintenance of my wife Elizabeth during her life. At her decease

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my son Montross Meares the tract or parcel of land whereon I now live. Containing six hundred and seventy two acres be the same more or less, with all the build ings, Wap, Woods, and waters thereto belonging as in any wise appertaining, to him and his heirs for ever

Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my six daughters Susannah Christina, Mary Elizabeth, Malinda and Catharine all all my house hold furniture to be Equally divided at the last discription

Still and such like, to my sons and daughters Jacob, James John, and Christopher E. Meares, Susannah McCascon Christy Vane, Mary, Adington, Catharine Perkins, Elizabeth Miller, a Malinda Carleton to be equally divided at the death of their mother and this to the entire exclusion of Montross Meares Considering his lands Estate to be his Equal share

And I hereby make and ordain my two sons Jacob and James Meares Executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof

I the said John Meares have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written signed published and attested by the said John Meares the testator as his last will and testament in the presence of us who are present at the time of signing and sealing thereof

I Carlist Ayres in the name of God amen being in a low condition of health at present but of sound mind and memory thank be to god for his mercies towards me for it I do hereby make and ordain this my last will and testament in the presence of god and these witnesses that is to say, the land that I have

a and for I devise or will to my son Jeremiah and that my wife is to enjoy the said land to raise her children on it as she lives, and the land that I have a bond for I allot to my son James Ayres when the same shall be paid for and for my other property. I allow James to have the young horse that I want my wife and the children to have after my debts is paid

the balance of the property, and at her death all the property to be sold and the profits arising therefrom to be divided among all my children in the following manner (viz) Levi, Moses, William's

Portion is to have five shillings each and the balance of the said property to be equally divided among the rest to (viz) James Morning, Jeremiah, Sally Baker and Michael F...

And that I do make and ordain William Boyton my worthy friend as my Executor to do my business to settle my debts and to get a right to the land aforesaid to the use of said in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
