will and Testament

I will and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Esther L King the tract of Land
whereon I now Live containing one hundred acres with its lots and boundaries

I will and bequeath all and singular all the balance of my lands to my
beloved wife Hannah during her Natural Life, and at her death to be sold
and the value thereof to be equally divided among all my Lawful heirs, (Except
Esther L King who is provided for above)

I appoint I McLeary & Jonathan L King my Executors of this my
last will and Testament This January thirty first in the year of our lord one
Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Two

formerly belonging to my daughter Brunetta also two ovens one bake pan
one Skillet one small pot The small Kettle and large pot also the Cupboard
and ware therein belonging also the table and knives and forks also the Loom
and furniture that belongs or goes with a Loom also the little or three
wheel and one Cotton wheel, And all the balance of my property is to
be divided amongst my other heirs as they may agree upon, or sold and
equally divided amongst them as they may elect This August the 25th 1863
