In the first I Joseph Reynolds do give to my two beloved sons Joseph P Reynolds and Daniel M Reynolds all the lands that I am now seized & possessed of together with all other goods and chattles of every ~~kind~~ nature and kind only I will hold a life time right in all the above specified property And is during my natural life and the natural life of my beloved wife and after the death of myself and wife, my two sons above named is to pay to each of the other Lawful heirs one hundred Dollars Each, But in the event that there should be a Doctor Bill or bills to be paid for me or for my wife for medicine and which we may or might need, the amount of said Bill or Bills is to be taken from the Amount which is to be paid to the other heirs and the balance to be equally divided to them Also my two sons above named is to support me and my wife during our lives
