and after the death of myself and wife, My two Sons above named is to pay
to each of the other Lawful heirs one hundred Dollars Each, But in the event
that there Should be a Doctor Bill or bills, to be paid for me or for my
wife for Medicine and what ever may or might need, the amount of said
Bill or Bills is to be taken from the Amount which is to be paid to the other
heirs and the balance to be Equally divided to them Also my two Sons
above named is to Support me and my wife During our lives
