My will is that the Residue of my property be

I hereby constitute and appoint my trusty  
friend R W Branch my Lawful Executor  
to all intents and purposes to execute this my  
last Will and Testament according to the true  
intent and Meaning of the same, and every part  
and clause thereof, hereby revoking and disclaiming  
utterly void all other Wills and Instruments by me  
herefore made in Testimony whereof I the
