The Last Will and Testament of Rebecca Dillingham 3^d

In the name of God amen I Rebecca Dillingham of the State of North Carolina and the County of Buncombe being in a reasonable State of health and a perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) do this then the 27 day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty four, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner following

First I resign my body to the dust and my Soul to God who gave it and as to worldly property that God has given I dispose of it as follows after all my debts and funeral Expenses are paid the balance of my Estate (to wit) one black woman my house hold and kitchen furniture of every kind all money and debts owing to me at my Decese I give and bequeath to my two daughters (to wit) Peggy Carson and Polly Barnard all the above named property debts and money to be Equally divided between the aforesaid Peggy and Polly to be divided by themselves and in case they Cant agree all the above named property debts and money are to be divided by two or more disinterested persons to be chosen by my Executor here after named and I the, a. Said Rebecca Dillingham do here by make and appoint W. J. Willson my Executor of this my last will and Testament in witness where of I the Said Rebecca Dillingham have here unto set my hand and Seal to this my last will and Testament date above written Signed Seald published and declared in the presence of us
